

THIS WEEK'S FEASTDAYS:

7th ST MEL - died in 488. He is said to have been a Briton who came to Ireland with Patrick, with whom he worked until he was ordained in Ardagh. He is one of the earliest Irish saints and gave the religious veil to Brigid.

11th: OUR LADY OF LOURDES

On this day in 1858. Our Lady first appeared to the fourteen year old Bernadette Soubirous. Later Bernadette was to learn that the mysterious lady was the Blessed Virgin and to hear from her lips, 'I am the Immaculate Conception'. In 1992, Pope John Paul 11 instituted the World Day of the Sick to be held on the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes.

On Wednesday mornings at 10.45am in the Dominican Ecology Centre and all are very welcome.


PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES
