Gift for all Time

The main feast of the Eucharist is Holy Thursday. The Corpus Christ feast was originated partly to stress the joy of the Eucharist which might be somewhat lost in the more sombre Holy week. While Holy Thursday also includes the washing of the feet, this feast is simply to commemorate the gift of Jesus in the Eucharist.

The body and blood of Jesus is the life of the Lord, 'given to us'. This gift is for all times. At scenes where Jesus feeds the people in the gospel, much is always left over. This is a sign of wanting to give his love for the life of the world for all time. This life, to death and resurrection, is commemorated in a real way at every Mass.

When a priest or minister gives communion, we are aware of the special moment this is for so many people. It is a moment of asking for help in life, for peace of mind, for the presence of the Lord. At a time of illness or bereavement we may recall the lift of grace when communion was

brought to us. On our side it is our promise also to share the Lord in different ways of love in our own lives.

Remember a time when receiving Communion bright you peace, joy or comfort. It is right and just 0 Lord, to give you thanks for the gift of yourself in the Eucharist.

#### MASS in ST JOSEPH'S RATHNEW

Reminder - the Saturday vigil at 7pm and the Sunday 9am Mass have both resumed in Rathnew. From Monday 14th June the normal 7pm Mass will resume on the Monday and Tuesday evenings. Numbers are restricted to 40 people and masks must still be worn while in the Church.

#### **Weekly Envelope Collection**

Parishioners should have received their new pack of envelopes by now and a huge thanks to the team of volunteers, who very kindly distribute the envelopes. Your help is very much appreciated at this time. Thank you to all who contribute to the support of the parish either through the envelope collection or by standing order each week throughout the year. Your continued generosity and support of the parish is also very much appreciated.

Thanks also to those who have signed up to the 'Tax Back' scheme which has made a huge contribution to parish funds at no extra cost to the donors. Any donations that exceed €250 calendar year are eligible for a tax rebate of up to 40% to the parish. All of the money donated in the weekly envelopes or by standing order is used for the running of the parish. This is the only money that stays in the parish. The monies given in the other two collections are for the payment of the salaries of the priests of the diocese (First Collection) and for the 'Share' fund which supports the services provided by the diocese (Second Collection).

If you are new to the parish and do not already receive a box of weekly envelopes and would like to do so, or if you would like to set up a standing order or avail of the 'Tax Back' scheme, please contact the parish office.

If you haven't received your box of envelopes, please let the office know and we will ensure delivery of same as soon as possible.

Once again, sincere thanks for your generosity over the past year and look forward to your continued support in the future.
