

#### **THIS WEEK's FEASTDAYS:**

15TH MAY: ST CARTHAGE, (OR MOCHUTA)

hailed from a rich family in Kerry. As he loved chanting of the psalms, the local king arranged for him to become a priest. Having spent a year possibly at Bangor he founded his own monastery at Rahan in 595. It grew rapidly. However, opposition made him move southwards around 637. Along with hundreds of monks and their patients from the leper colony he finally arrived at Lismore, where he made a foundation. He died in 638

#### <u> 16TH MAY : ST BRENDAN,</u>

Was a Kerry man who was born 486. He studied at Clonard under Finnian. His name is connected with many places in Kerry such as Ardfert and Mount Brandon. He visited Scotland and reached the Hebrides and possibly areas beyond. He founded a monastery in Clonfert in 568 and died there in 578

#### **20TH MAY : ST BERNARDINE**

was born in Siena in 1380. He became a Franciscan, travelled through Italy, preaching with great success. He promoted devotion to the Holy Name & to St Joseph. He died in 1444
