

Donal Neary S.J. Gospel reflection - Faith in action: On fire with hope

This story of Jesus highlights the inequality of rich and poor. Jesus appeals to our sense of justice, right and goodness. There is no need for anyone to come back from the dead to warn us of this inequality. The doors between rich and poor can often be locked as were the doors between Dives and Lazarus. Those outside can only knock, protest and even break down doors. The doors must be opened from the inside.

This message of justice and hope for an equal share of the world's goods for everyone is strong in the gospel of Jesus. His heart was on fire with the hope of a better life for the poor. He went to help them simply because they were poor.

The Christian Church, if it is to be faithful to the gospel, should be involved in many ways in the creation of a more just world. The Christian parish takes a special care for the refugee, the new poor, the unborn, the elderly, and in fact all whose voices may not be usually heard.


The parable is meant not to scare with images of punishment, but to make us as aware of the huge inequalities that exist in our world, and in

the exploitation of resources in the developing world.

Maybe we can pray not to be tormented by any of the pains of this story, but be tormented into action by the hunger, poverty and injustices of our world. Maybe then more doors can be opened from the inside of wealth to the outside of poverty.



Reflection on our 1st Pilgrimage to Lourdes.

When you enter the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes and participate in the Torch-light Procession you feel safe, at home, and ready to embrace healing. You are one of thousands of people gathered from all parts of the world, young and old, rich and poor, able bodied and wheelchair bound, and you come to sense that Lourdes is a special place.

You reflect deeply that Our Blessed Mother's Heart Is a Home for All, regardless of different ethnicities, colour of skin or language spoken.

Lourdes is a healing place for body and soul, where prayer brings peace, guilt is removed by forgiveness, brokenness is healed by light, and fear is replaced by love. The poverty of isolation is pushed away by a richer sense of community and belonging. The dignity of human life is restored and magnified.

As you walk, sing and pray you raise your lighted candle in thanksgiving for the Godly Contentment and Divine Love within you. You feel encouraged to pray many prayers of intercession, petition and heart-felt gratitude.

Each day you are on pilgrimage, your faith is strengthened by experiences of peace, love, fellowship and a blossoming of your innate goodness. Praying that we would return home with a stronger vibration of loving thoughts, and with hearts and helping hands more like those of Saint Bernadette.


