Our call is to flow with him, to go with the flow of God's Spirit. We are the flow of God in the world.


We become what we receive – the love of the Trinity in the world. We become like Christ



RE-OPENING OF CHURCHES - We are delighted to welcome all our Parishioners back to Mass. Like our last re-opening there are stewards at the doors and there are still seating restrictions within the Church. These restrictions are for everyone's safety as not everyone will have received their vaccines yet. So, once again, we request that people wishing to attend Mass will arrive early as numbers will be limited, sanitise hands on entry to Church, follow the stewards instructions and to continue to wear face masks while in the church.

BAPTISMS - We regret to announce that following directives issued by the Government this week, we have to postpone all Baptisms until further notice. Apologies to all the families that are affected by this action and have already re-booked their Baptism. But, unfortunately this situation is out of our control.

FUNERAL INFORMATION

We would like to bring to your attention that the fee for a funeral in the church was increased about a year ago to €400 per funeral. This was a Diocesan decision and nothing to do with individual parishes. The main reason behind this is that the income going into the Diocese to pay priests wages has declined considerably.

The €400 fee is divided up as follows:

A donation to the local priest doing the ceremony - this covers arranging the funeral with the family, the actual ceremony itself, and attending the burial.

A donation to the parish for the use of the church. This remains the same amount whether there is an evening removal or not.

A donation to the Common Fund which helps supports the priests in less well off parishes

A gratuity for the Sacristan on duty for the funeral Mass.

This breakdown also applies to donations for Baptisms and Weddings.
