Peter got great joy out of being a fisherman/ a businessman/ with his business partners. Especially when the catch was good and the money was flowing in from Rome and the cities east and west of Galilee. **J**esus offered more - for then/ for now and for always. Life to the full was to follow, even in suffering/ humiliation and death for Peter. **C**hrist is alive

The fish in the story represent all the people who will be found for **C**hrist.
