## Gospel Reflections Reminder from the Tree Donal Neary SJ

The tree was a big image for Jesus – he spoke many truths of his message pointing at trees,

vike mustard seeds which grew big,

~ vines that withered,

~ and the fig tree which was common to his hearers.

When asked about the signs of things to come, he gave no long homily, but just looked at the fig tree and said you know from this when summer and winter is coming. In the same way we can sense his presence in our lives in different ways. This may not help us to know about the end of time and the questions people had then, but it can get us to become aware of how God is present in our lives.

The word of God is spoken in the human words of many people. In kindly words, in forgiving and tolerant words, and also in the word of God spoken in the Mass, Jesus speaks to us today. Like the people looking at a fig tree, we can find his presence in the kindliness and the helpful words of another. This is the word of God in human form. It will not pass away.

We are called to speak his word in our way of life: \*to be friends of the earth, \*friends of all people, and \*friends of the poor. That's redemption, Jesus and ourselves working in unison.

God's book of compassion and love includes our names. We can be thankful our names are in the book of life.



#### **Christmas Care for Ukrainian Orphans:**

#### BRING JOY AFTER LOSS ...

Hello everyone I am reaching out to you for help, specifically with «Bring Joy after Loss.» This concerns children who, as a result of the full-scale war that has been ongoing for almost three years in Ukraine, have lost their parents, childhood, sense of safety, and joy. Due to the ongoing war, 13,000 children have lost parental care, with 1,759 of these children officially recognized as orphans in Ukraine. Since the onset of the war, I have been dedicated to supporting orphans in Ukraine. In the early weeks of the conflict, with the support of my family and the generous contributions of kind-hearted individuals, I raised €40,000. These funds were used to renovate the basement of a Ukrainian orphanage providing a safer space for the children. Two years ago, thanks to the incredible generosity of the residents of Wicklow Town and your parish in particular, I was able to raise around €8,000. This allowed us to purchase 1,000 new toys, bringing moments of joy to 1,000 Ukrainian children living in shelters and orphanages across the country. As a mother of three, I understand just how special Christmas is for children. And for us, as adults, it's important to make this time magical for them no matter what! It's incredibly difficult for me to accept that while my children may have more than they need, there are others who won't even receive a hug on Christmas morning, let alone a gift. That's why I believe in your understanding, compassion, love, and kindness—your ability to help me make a difference and bring joy after loss. «There is no such thing as someone else's child. All donations received will be directed toward purchasing Christmas toys for Ukrainian children who have lost their parents due to the war. Many thanks from the bottom of my heart. Tanya.


