The TAP & GO Machines on the stands at Our Lady's Side Door and the Main Door are for Diocesan collections. The donations received on these machines are for both the DIOCESAN COMMON FUND (which goes towards Priests salaries) & also the DIOCESAN SHARE FUND (which helps fund the workings of the diocese and poorer parishes). There is an automatic 60:40 split on these donations.

Going on holidays? Fruit and Vegetables left over? Excess garden vegetables? 


