Gospel Reflections Big Choices Donal Neary SJ

Big Choices We remember big and small choices in life. Ones that effected life totally like a job, marriage, retirement, redundancy; having an operation or many more. Or choices about the children that affected their lives – school, moving house, health issues.

Life is made up of many choices, big and small. Human, spiritual and religious choices. Peter had this sort of choice today. Would he go after Jesus or leave like others did.
